Eligibility: Masters degree with at least 60% marks, PGDFM and PGDM minimum OGPA of 3.33 in 4.33 maximum scale.

Admission is through following tracks: CAT, GMAT, UGC-CSIR NET, Written test conducted by IIFM for candidates with 5 years Post Masters experience, 4 years for engineering graduates.

- For FPM programme: No fee is charged. Monthly fellowship of Rs.12,000/- for first and second year, and Rs.14,000/- for third and fourth year are granted for non-sponsored

candidates . Contingency Grant of Rs.20,000/- per year, for four years, for purchasing relevant books, journals, etc. are also granted out of Institute's funds.
