Downloaded tender documents should be submitted along with the tender cost of Rs. 500/- and the EMD, failing which the tender will not be considered. IIFM reserves the right to refuse Tender documents to any party, and also to reject any or all the Tenders received without assigning any reason(s) thereof.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF DLP PROJECTOR (No. IIFM/M(P)/2010/01)

01. The Tenderer should submit following documents with the Tender, failing which the Tender will be rejected:
 - (a) Copy of Authorized Dealership Certificate for the product from the Company. (Authorization certificate should be valid currently and should be specific in reference to this Tender).
 - (b) Registration Certificate under the Shops & Establishment Act **1958**.
 - (c) Copy of CST/TIN No.
02. The rates quoted should be indicated in figures as well as in words and there should not be any overwriting as far as possible. Overwriting, if any, should be initiated. Brochure containing specifications of the product should be attached with the Tender.
03. Each and every page of the offer should be signed by the Tenderer before submission as a token of acceptance of the terms and conditions of Tender.. Corrections, if any should be duly attested. Unsigned tender documents will be rejected.
04. The quantities specified are only indicative and for the purpose of estimate only. The institute shall be at liberty to vary (delete/reduce/decrease) the quantum of the item. Also the Institute has the full right to order or not to order the item to the successful Tenderer.
05. The rates quoted (In Rupees) for the item should be inclusive of all taxes/ Duties etc, cost of material, labour charges, supply and installation at IIFM..No concession forms will be issued for any tax rebate.
06. **Earnest Money Deposit** (refundable) of **Rs. 10,000/-** should be submitted by way of Demand Draft drawn from any Nationalized Bank in favour of Director, Indian Institute of Forest Management, Bhopal, along with the Tender. Tender received without the EMD will be rejected. Down-loaded tender documents should be submitted along with tender cost of Rs. 500/- (non-refundable), failing which the tender will not be considered.
07. The Director, IIFM, Bhopal reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the offers in full or apart or to waive off any formality, minor deviations and omissions without assigning any reason(s) or to cancel the tender in whole. The Institute reserves the right to reject conditional Tenders and also relax any conditions of Tender at its discretion.
08. Submission of offers shall be treated as the acceptance of IIFM Terms and any counter terms shall not be accepted.

09. In case of non-compliance of the work order, the EMD/Security Deposit of the concerned party will be forfeited and the party will be blacklisted for 3 years.
10. In case of inferior/sub-standard supply, or supply not according to the Specifications approved, the Institute will have the right to reject the complete material and cancel the supply order.
11. In case of delay in supply, the Institute will have the right to impose penalty @1.5% (Will be calculated on per day basis) per month, of the total value.
12. The Institute is not in any way bound to accept the lowest or any quotation and reserves the right to accept any quotation in whole or any part of the quotation or portion of the quantity offered and reserves the right if required to negotiate with any or all the Tenderers without assigning any reason(s), whatsoever.
13. The selected party has to submit Performance Warranty Agreement, on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper towards warranty obligations for the items supplied.
14. The Tenderer should have own establishment, which can be inspected at call by IIFM, before finalization of the Tender.
15. If required, sample(s) of the item(s) shall be called from the parties for demo of the product for quality/performance assessment before deciding the party award of Purchase Order.
16. The criteria for deciding the party for award of the supply order will be based on the rate submitted by the parties, warranty offered for the item, as well as quality of samples of the items etc. Quality checking will be done by the Institute.
17. The Institute reserves the right to award the supply order for all items to a single party, or to different parties for different items as per the rates quoted.
18. Brochure containing the product details, and detailed specification sealed and signed by the Tenderer should be attached with the tender.
19. The Institute has the right to retain the rates of L-1 to L-3 parties as deemed fit.
